On this session we can show you how to:

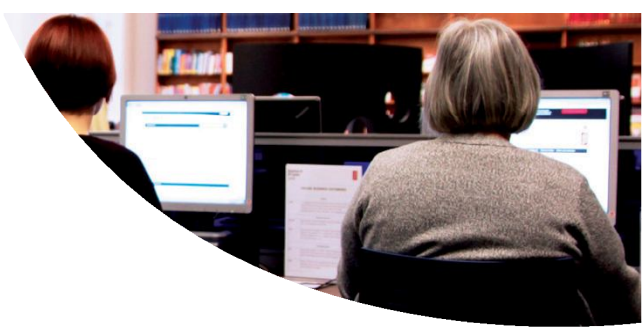
- Renew your library books or search our catalogue
- Check your bin collection day

- Search for council events and activities
- Create a MyLeeds account to request various services from the council and track the progress of your enquiry

Government services online

- Renew your car tax or renew your passport
- Book your driving theory test
- Apply for jobs, apply for benefits or register for student finance online

Coding

Code Clubs

Learn basic coding skills and discover how computer games, animations and websites are made. Learn how to use Scratch, Python and other programming languages

Raspberry Pi

Use the Pi to learn basic programming with fun, practical projects using this credit-card sized computer.

Sonic Pi

Learn to code creatively by composing or performing music. Define your own sounds, rhythm and tone and alter them while you play.

Minecraft Pi

The Raspberry Pi version of the game is the only one that comes with a programming interface. Write code and manipulate the world around you.

Gaming

Join our Adventures in Minecraft to improve your skills, learn new tricks and tips, meet other players and create your own worlds. Or use Bloxels to create your own game. Play, share and collaborate with friends.

Inventing

Create instant circuits for fool-proof inventing with LittleBits. Snap it all together to spark creativity and collaboration. Or use MaKey MaKey to turn everyday objects into replacements for your mouse and keyboard.

Crafting

Use Minecraft themed background cards and props or Lego bricks for endless storytelling. Use a special app to create and edit your stop-motion movies.

Boardmaker

Explore thousands of symbols to support visual communication

Boardmaker symbols can be used with anyone who may need additional support with communication. This could be children or adults with autism or anyone who has a condition or disability that affects communication. Create symbols for schedules, social stories or to support PECS.

On this session we will show you how to:

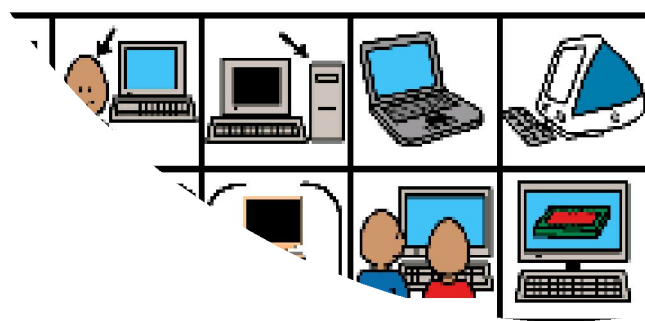
- Design your own boards and buttons

- Search billions of genealogy records on the Ancestry website
- Search census records and the world's largest collection of family trees
- Search the internet for other sites that can support your research
- Use Leodis Collections to view images on specific themes or use Leeds Playbills to view playbills from a wide range of Leeds theatres such as The City Varieties, The Grand, The Princess and The Theatre Royal.
